Safety Operating Systems Announces IS-BAO Support Services Affiliation

Washington, July 24, 2014: Safety Operating Systems (SOS) announced Thursday that it is now a participant in the IS-BAO (International Standard for Business Aviation Operations) Support Services Affiliate Program. In addition to offering Audit services for IS-BAO, SOS now has the ability to prepare organizations for the IS-BAO audit for Stage 1, 2, and 3.

The IS-BAO Support Services Affiliate Program was established to improve the quality of support services provided by organizations assisting operators in implementing the IS-BAO. Safety Operating Systems has demonstrated the knowledge of the IS-BAO and can provide services and products to business aircraft operators wishing to become or remain IS-BAO registrants. Specifically, the services provided will assist an operator to achieve, improve, or retain IS-BAO registration.

The standard is based on International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) standards that prepare the operator for both domestic and international operations.
